If you are having problems bathing, washing or dressing yourself, preparing food, even with help from equipment, you may need help from a care worker. For example, this could include a care worker to call daily to help you get washed and dressed in the morning and a further call in the evening to help you get ready for bed.

Your feedback will be considered as part of the development of the new contract and what we ask providers to do and how.

The new contract will be in place by autumn 2017.
