# Pride in Our Carers Awards 2017

## Award Category

### Carer of the Year

Nominate the family member, friend or neighbour you know who goes out of their way to help and support others and who makes a difference in someone's life.

*This category is for unpaid, family carers.*

### Young Carer / Young Adult Carer of the Year

Nominate the Young Carer (5-18) or Young Adult Carer (18-24) you know who goes out of their way to help and support others and who makes a difference in someone's life.

### Carer Friendly Employer of the Year

Nominate a local business or organisation who supports their employees or customers in their caring role. This can include an individual who has made a difference by going the extra mile on behalf of the business/organisation.

### Carer Friendly School or College of the Year

Nominate a School or College who has demonstrated a carer friendly approach in their caring role. This can include an individual who has made a difference by going the extra mile on behalf of the school/college.

### Carer Friendly Social Care Award

Nominate the Social Care team, care manager, youth worker or individual who has demonstrated the most carer friendly approach in their working role and who has made a difference by going the extra mile.

*This category includes paid care workers.*

### Carer Friendly Health Care Award

Nominate the GP surgery, Consultant, District Nurse, Health Care team or individual who has demonstrated the most carer friendly approach in their working role and who has made a difference by going the extra mile.

### Carer Friendly Voluntary Organisation Award

Nominate the Voluntary organisation, team or individual who has demonstrated the most carer friendly approach in their working role and who has made a difference by going the extra mile.
