It's all about making sure that young carers are involved in things that affect them, that they have a voice and that they are listened to. Centre 33's Young Carers Project wants to make sure that all 'young carers' (A young carer is a child or young person under the age of 18 who provides emotional and/or physical care to a loved one. This could be due to a disability, illness, poor mental health, drug or alcohol addiction) have a say and that they are heard.

The Young Carers Advisory Board (YCAB) will be a group of young carers who will meet to talk about the lived experience of young carers. This group will get to be included in making decisions about support services offered to young carers living in Cambridgeshire & Peterborough.

Can I be involved?

Are you under the age of 18? Do you live in Cambridgeshire or Peterborough? Are you a young carer?  
If the answers are yes, then yes you can be involved!



What can I expect?

- You will have to come to 4 Young Carers Advisory Board meetings per year and attend 5 training sessions (zoom and in person).
- You will be introduced to other young carers.
- 2 members of the group could get the chance to become Chair and Vice Chair of the Board.
- You would have to attend meetings but also do more work outside of group.
- You would get to plan the Young Carers Advisory Board meetings.
