### Young carers assessments

- Every young carer is entitled to an assessment of their needs under the Children and Families Act 2014
- This is irrespective of their age, who they care for or how much care they provide
- To request an assessment, call NCC Customer Services on 0344 800 8020.
- Young adult carers are also entitled to transitions assessments
- Guide to Young Carers Assessments
   (produced by Norfolk Young Carers Forum and Norfolk County Council).

# Young adult carer transitions assessments

The transition assessment (In Norfolk it is called 'My TAP' should support the young person and their family to plan for the future, by providing them with information about what they can expect and identifying barriers to a smooth transition into adult life.

All transition assessments must include an assessment of:

- Current needs for care and support and how these impact on wellbeing
- Whether the young carer is likely to have needs for care and support when they turn 18 and what those needs are
- The outcomes the young carer wishes to achieve in day-to-day life

# Young adult carer transitions assessments

Transition assessments for young carers must also specifically consider whether the young carer:

- is able to care now and after they turn 18;
- is willing to care now and will continue to after 18;
- works or wishes to do so;
- is or wishes to participate in education, training or recreation.
